Consolidated Contracting Activity (CCA)

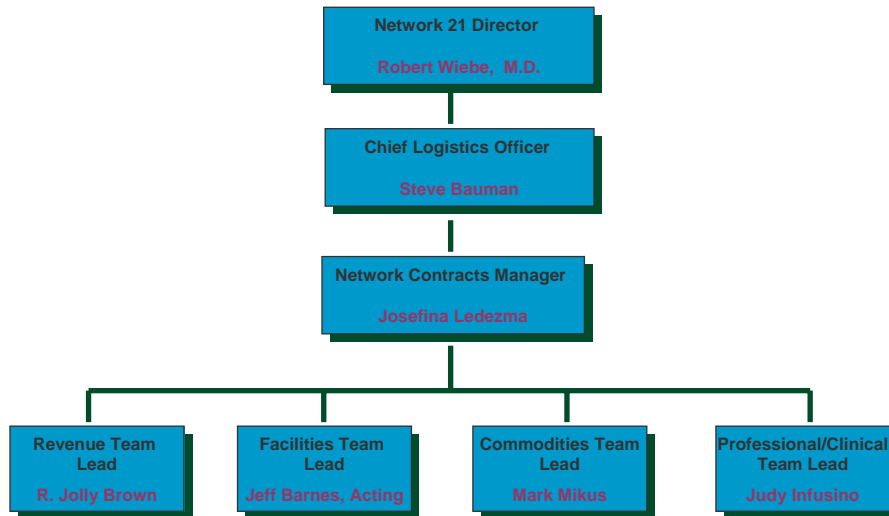
Contracting Officers:
